The Lethbridge Pregnancy Care Centre is a local Christian agency offering compassionate support and education for women and men facing unexpected pregnancy, counsel for pregnancy related losses, and programs encouraging healthy sexual choices.

"When my girlfriend told me that she was pregnant, I didn't know what to think. Things were already uncertain between us. And now a baby? I wasn't ready to be a dad.

I had so many questions - what would child support look like? Visitation? How would this impact my current financial assistance program? So many unknowns.

My client advocate at the Centre didn't know all of the answers, but she found people and organizations who could help with them. She helped me plan a budget and think about how I could afford a baby on my current income. She talked with both my girlfriend and me, answering our questions and being encouraging.

I'm still scared, but I'm getting used to the idea of being a dad. I think it's going to be ok."

Impacting our Clients' Stories

Information & Client Care Support

Clients receive thorough and accurate information about pregnancy, parenting, adoption, and abortion at their request. Volunteers trained as client advocates walk alongside women and men facing unexpected pregnancies, providing appropriate information and support through the decision-making process.

Free Pregnancy Tests

Any woman who suspects she may be pregnant is welcome to receive a free, self-administered pregnancy test. The LPCC is not a medical facility and every client is encourageed to follow up with their doctor.

Practical Support

As part of our commitment to provide ongoing support, clients are able to receive baby and maternity clothes monthly. One-time emergency packages (which may include diapers, formula, bus passes and grocery cards) are given to clients in extreme need.

Adoption Referrals & Support

Open or closed adoption information is provded based on the specific desires of the client. Volunteer client advocates walk alongside clients who choose to make an adoption plan for their child both before and after the adoption is finalized.


Post-Abortion & Grief Care

Women and men who have an abortion experience in their past are provided with a safe place to work through emotions, including grief and regret. Client advocates are specifically trained to navigate this often difficult journey, showing unconditional love and support for the client.


Finances
