"We can't have a baby. I'm not ready to be a dad."

As Eliza* hung up with the abortion clinic, that earlier conversation with her boyfriend rang in her ears. She sat for a minute before picking up her phone and doing a quick google search. She landed on the Lethbridge Pregnancy Care Centre's website and sent an email.

"Hi, I'm pregnant and scared. I have an appointment with the abortion clinic to end it. My boyfriend doesn't want the baby...but I'm not sure. Can we talk?"

That same week Eliza had her first session with an LPCC client advocate over Zoom. She talked and expressed how scared and conflicted she felt. Her client advocate was able to listen and help Eliza process the shock of the pregnancy. She encouraged Eliza to slow down and take some time to think about what SHE wanted the outcome of this situation to be. She told her not to let anyone else pressure her into a decision she didn't want.

Despite her partner's wishes, Eliza decided that she would continue her pregnancy and raise her child as a single parent if needed. Empowered with the love of her supportive family and resources from the LPCC, Eliza gave birth to a healthy baby girl nine months later. The Centre continues to support both mom and baby as they grow.

Mission Statement

The Lethbridge Pregnancy Care Centre is a local Christian agency offering compassionate support and education for women and men facing unplanned pregnancy, counsel for pregnancy related losses and programs encouraging healthy sexual choices.



Supporting clients through...

Information & Client Care Support

We provide thorough and accurate information about pregnancy, parenting, adoption, and abortion at the request of the client. Volunteers are trained as client advocates to walk alongside clients facing an unintended pregnancy and present appropriate information. Client advocates journey with clients and offer support as they make their decision. They also continue caring for clients by helping them access physical supports and walking with them as they work through their emotions.

Practical Support

The clothing room (containing both baby and maternity clothes) is available to clients on a monthly basis. One-time emergency packages (which can include diapers, formula, bus passes, and grocery cards) are given to clients in extreme need. The LPCC also provides new mothers with layettes full of new baby items. Outside community resources are referred when applicable.

Free Pregnancy Tests

Any client who suspects she may be pregnant is welcome to come for a free, self-administered pregnancy test. LPCC is not a medical facility and every client is encouraged to follow up with their doctor.

Adoption Referrals & Support

Open or closed adoption information is provided based on the specific desires of the client. If a client chooses to make an adoption plan for their child, their LPCC client advocate will walk alongside them as they make that journey.

Post Abortion & Grief Care

We offer both individual care and support groups for clients who have made an abortion decision. Our client advocates are specifically trained to navigate this often difficult choice while showing unconditional love and support for the client.








